

Conferences and Events:

SaySo Orientation: June 6-8, 2003 was held in Burlington, where the old and new board members got together for training and fellowship. We also had a chance to meet George Duval, and alumni from Kentucky who plans to speak at Advocacy in Action.

SaySo Rally: July 31, 2003 was held in Greensboro, at the Youth Folk Center where the teens learned valuable skills to take back to the community.

LINK-Up Youth Conference: August 1, 2003 was held in Greensboro, N.C. at the Youth Folk Center where teens learned about decision making skills, taking pride in your appearance, and reducing AIDS & HIV Infections.

Growing Pains Conference: August 13-16, 2003 was held in Orlando, Florida where Vivian, Chaney, Makeisha, and Melinda attended. **Melinda won the National Youth of the Year Award**. This is the second year that a SaySo member won this award!! Awesome!

Partnership Update (did you know we partner with these groups?)

Guardian Ad Litem (GAL) is trying to improve services for teens. We have two of our SaySo board members on this committee, Melinda and Thomas.

Advocates for Children Services supported a petition because the governor and his advisory committee had not met to make recommendation to improve youth services in mental health and juvenile justice. The committee is finally meeting after two years. Also, developing a foster youth handbook.
