### What's new in NC for foster youth?

NCREACH scholarships are now available - Any Foster Youth who has aged out of Foster Care or was adopted after 12 is NOW eligible for up to \$11,000 to attend a NC community college or a NC 4 year college.

Foster Care Board Rate Increase - The NC Legislation just increased the amount of \$\$ that Foster Parents receive. This money is there to help pay for extra curricula activities - For Foster Youth ages 13-18 the rate is now \$634!!!! (Effective January 2009).

Medicaid available for Foster Youth until 21 - The North Carolina legislature recently approved funding to provide Medicaid coverage to young adults now aged 18 to 21 who aged out of the North Carolina foster care system. This is available without regard to your income or assets. In order to apply for benefits, go to your local county Department of Social Services to apply. You will need to apply for all Medicaid programs. Make sure you take proof of citizenship, residency and your income with you when you apply!
